The Prince George's County Office of the State's Attorney has an opening for an Assistant Chief of the Youth Justice Unit. This is an exempt position, meaning the Assistant State's Attorney is a political appointment and serves at the pleasure of the State's Attorney.

TYPICAL DUTIES:

Typical duties for the Assistant Chief of the Youth Justice Unit include: Assist with training and supervising Attorneys and Legal Assistants; Assist the Chief with case review and assignment, trial preparation, in-court supervision, diversion programs, Teen Court, and daily contact with the Prince George's County Department of Juvenile Services (DJS), the Prince George's County Police Department ((PGPD), and other law enforcement agencies; Involved in contact with citizens, as well as regular attendance at meetings (day and some nights) with our partners.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION FOR CANDIDATES:

Candidates must be admitted to the Maryland Bar and have a minimum of four (4) years of prosecution experience. Prior experience prosecuting juvenile cases is preferred.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT: Candidates must pass a background investigation and drug screen.

ELIGIBILITY TO WORK: Under the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, an employer is required to hire only U.S. citizens and lawfully authorized alien workers. Selected candidate for employment will be required to show and verify authorization to work in the United States.
